Sunday Eucharist - Year A; Weekday Eucharist and Divine Office – Year 2

Please note: As of General Chapter 2018, we use the term **Major Feast (MF)** for feasts previously denoted as Double Feasts that take Precedence of a Sunday (D-PS). At the Eucharist on Principal Feasts and Major Feasts, the intercessor prepares the prayers as for a Sunday. When a specific litany is noted in the bulletin or on the hymn board, that is the litany we will use. If no specific litany is assigned, we will use Litany #1 (BAS p. 110), sung or said. We omit the Confession and Absolution.
